I fully understand and accept all the above risks. Agree if any claim for personal injury or wrongful death is commenced against releases, he/she shall defend, indemnify and save harmless from any and all claims or causes of action by whomever or wherever made or presented for his/her personal injuries, property damage or wrongful death. I fully understand and accept all of the above risks and hereby release and hold harmless the City of San Diego, the San Diego Unified School District, and Prime of Life Women's Soccer League, including board members, all participants and referees, from all liability for any and all injuries, claims, or damages that I may sustain for my participation in this league activity.

Participant acknowledges and understands POLWSL reserves the right to photograph facilities, activities and program participants for potential future use. All photos remain the property of the league and may be used for publicity and promotional services.

Participant acknowledges that she has read the above paragraphs and understands these waivers and releases are necessary to allow the activities of POLWSL to exist in its present form.

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1) I, as a player will behave with respect and dignity to all other players, referees, and fans. This includes playing the game in a manner that allows for good competition but does not take away the ability of the opposing team to have an opportunity to be in the game.
- 2) No swearing or gestures to other players, referees, fans, or to yourself.
- 3) Respect integrity and judgment of the referees.
- 4) Any discussion with other team or referees on issues during the game is to be done only by the Team Captain.
- 5) Stress values derived by playing the game fairly and for the enjoyment of the game for everyone.
- 6) No discrimination will be allowed that exhibits racial, ethnic, religious, or sexual harassment.
